Clients with Diminished Capacity: Rising to the Challenges of an Aging Clientele

As more people live longer and work longer, attorneys will encounter more clients who have reached an advanced age, whether they are seeking to purchase real estate, sell a business, pursue a personal injury claim, or get married. Engaging with a greater number of elderly clients also means, tragically, working with a greater number of clients at risk for dementia, especially Alzheimer’s disease. Cognitive impairments can affect every aspect of the representation and properly addressing them is critical to protecting your client and your practice.

This program examines an attorney’s duty to assess and monitor a client’s mental capacity, including strategies for doing so. It also will address certain actions that an attorney might take to mitigate the effects of a client’s impairment or to insulate the client from harm. The program concludes with a discussion of the potential legal and disciplinary consequences for taking unjustified action or failing to respond entirely.
